




Centre For Disabled

Major Achievements

Altogether 134 beneficiaries were assisted with different mobility devices by CFD centre during the reporting period from different administrative district areas of Sri Lanka. CFD centre has received 71 newly registered beneficiaries and 63 secondary beneficiaries for services and assistance. of them were registered



In total 90 mobility devices were delivered to the needy and most vulnerable beneficiaries during the period. It includes Prosthetics, Orthotics, Mobility devices, Assistive devices and Repairs.

3 mobile P&O clinic services had been successfully conducted at Batticaloa district to assess and deliver the Prosthetic devices for the selected beneficiaries. Altogether 16 number of below knee and above knee prosthetic devices were delivered to the selected beneficiaries who sought these valuable and essential services to ensure daily routine function of their life.

A Denmark based organization called VSFEE (Vani Social Foundation for Economic Empowerment) financially supported and organized this remarkable event jointly with Caritas-Valvuthayam. These devices were assessed in the month of March and they were delivered to the beneficiaries in the very next month of April 2021.

Beneficiary Selection

Caritas-Valvuthayam had received applications from 150 university students 175 school students who were indeed in need of financial support to meet their educational expenses to continue their studies. Based on the financial allocation received from donors Caritas- Valvuthayam managed to support only 47 university students and 112 school going children who were selected based on the donor requirement of vulnerability criteria.

Beneficiary selection criteria are as follows below.

- 1. War affected children.
- 2. Orphan children
- 3. Women headed and widows and widower families.
- 4. Differently able families.
- 5. High number of family members.

Stromme Foundation funded project - Exit plan with stakeholders

Caritas Valvuthayam joined hands with Stromme Foundation in 2010 for for the relief assistance of war affected resettled people. As the IDPs started moving to their own places of origin in the resettlement process, the same funding organization extended its funding assistance for socio - economic enhancement of returnees at 20 villages in Madhu DS division. Through livelihood assistance, Caritas Valvuthayam paved ways for 1550 families for sustainable income sources, formed 156 Self-Helped Groups and established 20 community based organizations.

Unfortunately time has come for Stromme Foundation to exit SriLanka at the end of 2021. At this exit point, Caritas Valvuthayam for the continuous functions of community mechanism, registered 02 CBOs under social service act and 18 CBOs under cooperative act. Still, it is felt the necessity of linkages between CBOs, cooperative department, divisional secretariat and local NGOs. As a result, an exit strategic plan meeting was organized on 23rd of February, 2021 at Madhu DS office under the guidance of ADS. 55 participants, authorities from cooperative department, DS office, local NGOs and CBO members, contributed in the meeting. All stakeholders, shared their service availability for CBOs; monitoring, mentoring, guidance, training, annual audit, support for local fund raising, capacity building, market linkages, exposure visits, post harvesting technologies etc.

It was an interesting meeting for the officials to know about the greatest achievements of CBOs: micro fiancé loan system, livelihood assistance, school monitoring, advocating for social needs, working for child / gender protection, advocacy, campaigns / protests, work against corruption, shiramadana activities in common places, data collection/sharing with field level government officials, relief assistance during covid19 etc. Assistant Director of Planning in his feedback said that for the first time he heard a lot of good things done by community based organizations for the development of their own community members. Further he said that they are ready to support such capacitated CBOs even after exit'.



Inauguration of Seeds Bank at Keerisuddan.

In this COVID pandemic season, the CBO of Keerisuddan noticed that many young people were staying at home without any working opertunities. Therefore, they planned to promote groundnut cultivation with the support of a local NGO called Mulla.

Based on the knowledge gained through the training program on "Proposal Writing" conducted by Caritas - Valvuthayam, in collaboration with the Mannar Chamber the CBO developed a proposal. The proposal was approved by the local authority and the CBO received a bulk of 100Kg seeds. With an agreement with the Youth Club, of Keerisuddan, the CBO has started a "SEED BANK" and the bank's provision of seeds for groundnut cultivation this season has encouraged those young people. The yield seeds will be collected from the beneficiaries during the harvest time as per the contract. The CBO disbursed LKR 5,000.00 as a recoverable loan to cover their additional expenses.

Activeness of a children club

Kalmdhu children club was formed by Caritas - Valvuthayam under the Stromme Foundation Project in 2012 in order to ensure child friendly environment for children. For the capacity improvement and leadership qualities of all children club members Caritas with the support of child protection unit at Madhu Divisional Secretariate provided training on child protection, leadership and importance of education. Further, in order to promote their reading habits and leisure time activities, library books and play kits were donated by Caritas. Also, exposure visits and educational tours to the Southern part of Sri Lanka, made the children experienced with different culture.

All these inputs boosted the children club to become independent body at Kalmadu village to work for their own community and advocate for their rights. Under the supervision of field staff, field animators and community based organizations, children club members have successfully made the following achievements;

- 1. Conduct regular monthly meetings
- 2. Organized drawing competitions to create covid 19 awareness among their members
- 3. Celebrated Thaipongal festival
- 4. Mobilized their members to receive learning materials from local NGOs; Vanni Makkal Kappaham and Velicham Arakaddalai.
- 5. Organized children's day celebration inviting SDO and GN.
- 6. Launched a tree planting event in the premises of preschool and GN office.
- 7. Under environmental protection, they started collecting polythene waste from their village

Youth exposure to middle range farms in the districts of Mullaitivu and Trincomallee

For the encouragement and preparation of self employment program by government, Caritas Valvuthayam planned to take 45 youth from Madhu DS division to Mullaitivu and Trincomallee where the youth are exposed to coconut farm, cadju farm, mango farm, teak state and organic farm. Youth exposure to see such middle range farms in Mullaitivu and Trincomallee paved way for the youth from rural villages to gather knowledge and prepare themselves for the government land donation program.

Objectives

- 1. To provide an opportunity to 45 youth through an exposure to such big farms in Mullaitivu and Trincomallee
- 2. To prepare well the youth with practical knowledge and experience through cross learning exercise
- **3.** To create a healthy environment for youth to ask questions freely and gather knowledge about different types of possible farms
- 4. To ensure rural village youth have access to government lands by passing the interview
- 5. To increase youth employment and local economy

Job Bank

The Caritas-Valvuthayam joined hands with Madhu DS office and human resource unit at Kachchery Mannar to establish divisional level job bank in Madhu DS office. In the first stage animators were trained by human resource department to collect the details of unemployed youths in the division. Indeed, 200 youths' details were collected from SF target villages in Madhu division and handed over to human resource officer at DS office. At the end, human resource officials from Mannar Kachcheri organized a massive job fair at Madhu DS office bringing potential employees such as insurance companies, private companies and VT centers. More than a hundred youths participated in it and 6 private companies were present and each done their presentation about job opportunities and service of their company. Finally, youth individually met the employees and submitted their Bio Datas.

Food Security

Provision of Poultry chicks

Caritas valvuthayam had distributed poultry chicks to 42 number of selected beneficiaries from the DS divisions of Madhu, Manthai west and Nanattan of Mannar district. the objective of this activity was to motivate and promote self employed long standing livelihood activity to reduce poverty. This event was held on 06th of May 2021 under the Food Security programme.



Capacity Building Programme for Farmers.

Caritas Valvuthayam Organized and conducted knowledge based capacity building programs on organic advance techniques training for farmers. The seeds packs were distributed to 578 home garden beneficiaries through the Food Security program at Sinna pandivirichan, Kalmadhu, Periya murippu and Kunchukkulam to encourage the training participants to actively engage in organic farming. The Agricultural instructor from Mannar Agrarian department also participated and explained the importance of organic home garden at household level and disadvantages of consuming vegetable at open markets etc.

Awareness training Program for School Children

An awareness training seminar on the importance & Advantages of organic farming to school children was conducted to motivate them to involve in organic home gardening and give practical awareness to the children on Organic farming in the school and home. The gardening tools and equipment package was delivered to Mn/Thadchanamaruthamadhu RCTMV school.



An awareness programme for mothers on the importance of nutrition food

Under food security project, Caritas - Valvuthayam Mannar organized an awareness programme for mothers on nutrition food at Al- Madeena preschool- Madeena nagar on 30.03.2021. The illage level Mid wife of Madhu clinic center was the resource person of the above programme. The resource person explained about the importance of having nutritious meals in day today life. 17 parents of preschool children had participated in this programme and had been refreshed their knowledge on the importance of home garden at preschools.

Participatry Rural Appraisal Program

Caritas Valvuthayam Mannar conducted PRA workshop under the food security project at Thadchanamaruthamadhu, Mullikkulam, Sothinagar, Keerisuddan, Parasankulam, Vilaththikkulam, Sinnavalayankaddu, Palampitty, Thekkam, Kalmadhu, Kunchukkulam, Mathakiramam, Pannaivedduvan, Sinna pandivirichan, Mankindy, Iranai iluppaikkulam, Periya murippu, Kaddayadampan and Poomalanthan villages of Madhu DS division. In total 578 Beneficiaries participated in these programs along with GNs and Dos of respective villages.



Distribution of Nutrition Food packs and Seeds packs.

Caritas valvuthayam Mannar has distributed nutrition food packs and seeds packs to 375 mothers of the preschool children at Madhu DS division on 29th and 30th of June 2021 under the Food security Covid 19 response programme.

These beneficiaries were selected from 20 several preschools in the DS division of Madhu. The Family Health Officers advised those mothers how to promote their organic home gardening activities and maintain the nutritional level of their children.

Provision of saplings to the beneficiaries.

Through the Food security Covid 19 response intervention, Caritas-Valvuthayam Mannar had distributed tree plants to 250 numbers of selected beneficiaries. Four varieties of saplings were distributed to those who are interested in home gardening such as domestic vegetable garden, coconut and doemestic fruits garden etc. Differently able families, low-income families, and women headed families beneficiaries were selected from the 20 targeted villages in the Divisional Secretariat division of Madhu.



Housing & Livelihood

Housing Project orientation workshop for newly selected MISEREOR funded housing project scheme.

Caritas-Valvuthayam has received the endorsed housing beneficiary list from respective divisional level government authorities for Misereor funded housing project scheme. The housing project target beneficiaries are War affected Refugee returned families from India. In total 24 beneficiary list was finalized (from Mannar district 21 and Vavuniya district 3) for 2nd phase of housing project implementation in Mannar Diocese. The project orientation workshop session was organized for selected housing project beneficiaries on the 20th April 2021 at Valvuthayam.

Caritas - Valvuthayam Director Rev. Fr. S. Anton had addressed the introductory session and briefed the participants about the objective of the orientation session and sole responsibilities of beneficiaries and their family members to complete the housing project successfully as scheduled.

Caritas-Valvuthayam provided livelihood assistance packages to 30 selected beneficiaries at Kokkupadayan village under the MISEREOR funded livelihood project. Each beneficiary had received a livelihood package worth of LKR 75,000.00 as revolving fund and this fund will be revolved among the particular CBO members. This livelihood funds will be managed by CBO as community managed micro finance activity. Caritas-Valvuthayam will monitor and facilitate the CBO activity.

Housing & Livelihood



With the financial support of Miserior, and the instructional support of Caritas-SEDEC, Caritas-Valvuthayam implemented a housing project for Indian returnees in Mullikkulam, Musali Divisional Secretariat. In the first phase, 20 out of 50 houses have been completed.



The foundation stone-laying event was held in several villages in the districts of Mannar and Vavuniya. The construction works are in progress.



Through the MISIRIOR project Caritas-Valvuthayam distributed livelihood support to 30 number of beneficiaries at Kokkupadayan village. Each received a livelihood package worth LKR 75,000.00 and this fund will be circled as a revolving fund among them. As a first phase 30 beneficiaries received and settled their loans and as a second phase another 37 beneficiaries got their chance.

Returnees from India

A project orientation session and skill development training programme Was organized for Refugee returnees from India.

A project orientation session and skill development training programme was organized by Caritas-Valvuthayam for Refugee returnees who had returned from India and struggling to uplift their dignified life. Caritas - Valvuthayam Director Rev.Fr. S. Anton had opened the training session by welcoming the participants with his introductory opening session. The training was held at Caritas-Valvuthayam training hall on the 9th March 2021. In total 65 participants actively participated and benefitted from this training session.

The objective of this training session was to empower and capacitate beneficiaries with skills and knowledge to identify their suitable livelihoods based on their capacity, knowledge, interest and past experience. At the end of the training session the beneficiaries had quoted that the workshop was very much beneficial for them and agreed to discuss with their family members regarding their preferable livelihood packages based on the knowledge gained from workshop. Beneficiaries were given two weeks time to submit their proposal to Caritas-Valvuthayam for necessary action.



Advocacy empowerment awareness training workshop for Refugee Returnees from India.

Advocacy awareness one day training session was organized on available government public services and other service providers for refugee returned beneficiary families in Mannar district. The training was held at Caritas-Valvuthayam on 12th April 2021 and in total 46 beneficiary participants participated the training session. The child probation officer attached with Social service department at Manthai West Divisional Secretariat of Mannar district had facilitated the training session. The objective of this training workshop was to empower participants and make vigilant on available government public services for refugee returned families and available referral networking services locally to address and find solutions to the identified community social issues and needs. The awareness training workshop was implemented under Korea caritas-funded Refugee returnees' project.
